FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

Who can take part in book clubs?

Any woman who enjoys reading and would like to meet with friends about the books read to exchange ideas.

How will the book club be organized?

The club will be a small group of women. No officers or formal structure will be required. Facilitators, if needed, will volunteer to pose discussion questions.

How often do we meet and where?

The group gets together once a month at a suitable coffee shop or restaurant.

What will we read?

Each member in the group may recommend two books in the course of a year. The group may read fiction, nonfiction, or a mix of both.

Will we read mainstream titles and bestsellers?

Although the books will not be censored, Philippians 4:8 is the guideline: "...beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about those things."

What is the format for the monthly meeting?

The member who chooses the book for the month will come to the meeting with three questions to encourage discussion. Members may bring prayer requests, but the meeting's real purpose is to review books and discuss them.

How can I get in the book club?
